### REAL ID REQUIREMENT EXTENDED TO OCTOBER 2020!

Department of Homeland Security has granted South Carolina's request for extension to become REAL ID compliant. The latest extension expires on October 2020. Starting next October, Fort Jackson will no longer accept South Carolina Driver's License as the sole form of identification. Though it is NOT mandatory for a SC resident to get a SC REAL ID DL, but for entry onto military installations, air travel, etc. REAL ID is required. Golf Club members/patrons without a form of identification that is REAL ID compliant are encouraged to obtain the South Carolina REAL ID Driver's License. If a person elects not to get a REAL ID, they must provide additional identification in order to access the Installation. Acceptable forms of identification are as follows: Proof of Identity (examples: Birth certificate or valid US Passport), Proof of Social Security Number (examples: Social

Security card or W-2 Form that has your social security number and name and your employer's name), Two Proofs of Current, Physical SC Address (examples: current, unexpired SC license or ID and a no more than 90-day-old utility bill with the same name and address). Proof of all legal name changes (examples: marriage license or court order issued by your county's probate or family court. One must show a complete name

Golf Channel. The winners of the twelve scheduled qualifiers for the Military Long Drive Championship will compete for the MLD. Fort Jackson Golf Club will host a qualifier on Saturday, March 30. The MLD Qualifier is open to active duty, retired military, National Guard and reservists. In the Men's Division of the WLD, it is anticipated that over 50 of the "longest hitters in the land" will attempt to qualify for the final stage of the 2019 World Long Drive Championship. There will also be 10-20 women competing to advance to the finals of the Women's Division of the World Long Drive Championship. Qualifying for the WLD will take place on May 5 & 6. Both competitions will take place on the first hole of the Wildcat Course. Expect to see some changes to the tree lines and greenside bunkering of #1 to accommodate the 450 yard long, 50 yard wide grid needed to host the WLD qualifier.

Also, The Golf Channel will be on site in late April to begin setting up the hitting platform, grandstands (1000+seating) and laying out the competition grid. You can expect to see Wildcat #1 set up as a par four, as well as, modified routing for cart and player traffic for a couple of weeks. Play on Wildcat will also be restricted during the competition. We will be reaching out for volunteers to assist on the Driving Range and on the competition grid once requirements are finalized. This will be a great opportunity to showcase FJGC and Fort Jackson. ### CG'S QUARTERLY GOLF TOURNAMENT March 15!



The FJGC Junior Golf Camps have seen significant growth over the past couple of years and we'd like to see more growth in 2019! ON THE COURSE... Another spring is on the horizon and we will welcome it with open arms, seeing the

turf return to green and the warmer playing conditions is a good thing. The winter was wet, but fortunately warm for the most part and the greens are awake and growing as we have been mowing them daily for the past three weeks. All the turf that was good going into the winter has returned for the spring with the exception of #14 Wildcat and #12 Old Hickory. Both of these greens along with multiple greens with small patches of last years damaged areas will be re-sodded starting in two weeks. We have coordinated with the "Champion Turf" folks out of Texas to have two truckloads of sod shipped in to make the repairs to the damaged greens. The first load will be applied to the small damaged areas on the multiple greens and the next will be applied to the entire damaged greens. The staff over the winter has taken on the project of pruning

The staff over the winter has taken on the project of pruning low hanging limbs around the courses and we think it looks and feels much more open and cleaner in areas were the limbs had grown very low. We have also been sodding some of the damaged areas in fairways to include #1 Wildcat and #11 Wildcat. Wildcat #1will also be hosting the National Long Drive Championship the first of May, so you will be seeing some changes made to accommodate the event. We will be overseeding the entire hole this week and sodding in the greenside bunkers only for the event.

Thanks for all the positive comments to the repairs and improvements. We encourage the open communication on the status of your courses. If you ever have questions you feel are not addressed to your satisfaction please email me directly and we can chat about your understanding of the results that you are seeing. ### GOLF SHOP NEWS

As spring arrives, so comes a variety of new merchandise and golf equipment. New in the shop for the ladies are clothing from EP Pro and Bermunda Sands. A variety of golf accessories to include FootJoy and Adidas shoes, Clicgear push carts, Golf Buddy range finders and Titleist hats.

What Callaway, Ping, and TaylorMade are Saying... Callaway's primary goal has been to increase ball speed to deliver what most golfers want-more distance. That was the basis of the Jailbreak technology when it debuted on the original Callaway Epic. The latest enhancement to Callaway Epic Flash is to deliver even more ball speed across the entire face of the club, on both center and off-center strikes. The engi-



neers at Callaway used Artifical Intelligence to help design the face this time. Long story short, Callaway *claims* that they will deliver more distance for golfers yet again while working within the limita-

tions of the USGA.

<u>Ping:</u> Even though Ping's new family of drivers has a model with an adjustable center of gravity (G410 Plus), the line retains its extreme stability. This means your mis-hits will be nearly indistinguishable from your center strikes. One key feature is a weight-saving, super-thin crown designed with narrow support

veins like those on a dragonfly's wings. This allows the Plus model to have a 16-gram weight that seamlessly fits into draw, neutral and fade positions in the rear perimeter. On the lighter, slice-fighting SFT model, extra mass moves to the heel to help you square the face at impact.

TaylorMade: Instead of extra adjustability, some of us just want maximum forgiveness. In place of sliding weights, large panels of carbon composite fill the sole. They flank a weighted center section, allowing mass to be placed low and deep on the standard model. There's also a D-Type with 46 grams in the heel area to beat back a slice. And the face? Like the M5, the twisted-face shape helps minimize mis-hits. Taylor-Made also starts with an extra-fast (nonconforming) face. Then, the head is injected with resin to bring the speed back under the limit. This intense manufacturing process aims to push every TaylorMade face closer to the edge than the norm.

Fit your driver, fairway woods, irons, and putter. Ask one of the Golf Professionals about getting fitted. If you have any questions or need any assistance concerning golf equipment or special orders please ask the Pro Shop Staff.

HANDICAP CART POLICY

Recently, numerous concerns have been voiced regarding abuse of the Handicap Cart Policy. In order to obtain enhanced cart access due to physical limitations, one must submit the required documentation to the Admin Office which is then reviewed by members of the GAC. Patrons are reminded that carts MUST be kept at least 20 feet from the putting surfaces. Also, carts are NOT permitted between the green and bunkers. Everyone's cooperation is greatly appreciated.

We are happy to announce that Fort Jackson Golf Club will again be participating in this year's PGA Junior League Golf (PGAJLG) in 2019. Our minimum goal is to fill a 12-player team which consists of boys and girls ages 13 and under, in order to participate in the June-July regular season. If participation grows significantly, we will conduct our own PGA Junior League with all matches being played at FJGC. The final scheduling details are currently being worked out. Price is only \$175.00 per child. Registration deadline is April 30th!

The PGAJLG, the fastest growing junior golf program, was created in 2011 as an idea to join the successful "little league baseball" concept that many of your kids and yourself grew up playing with the great game of golf created by League Golf out of Atlanta, GA. In their first year there were 120 teams representing four select markets. This concept was launched nationally in 2013 after the continued success in the 2012 season. PGA Junior League is designed to better socialize the game of golf for boys and girls ages 13 and under. The competitions are structured in a "team vs. team" format with the teams in leagues depending on geographical location. The juniors play the less stressful and very popular scramble format as opposed to stroke play.

Teams consist of 10-12 junior golfers; they wear team jerseys, home and away, with numbers to represent the "little league" concept. This concept also flowed into how the teams compete. The idea is to create as many birdies, pars and even eagles as possible, just like getting players to make contact while learning to hit in baseball. The format is a scramble format with the matches scored using matchplay so the players are battling each other and not the course. This has proven to provide a much more fun and less stressful environment for the juniors.

PGAJunior League Golf will be a fun, Family-oriented activity with parents serving as Team Managers and Team Moms. So parents, be prepared to participate, too!

The Columbia league schedule for this season takes place from June through July with Regional and National Championships in August and September. This is not a yearlong, time consuming initiative. It encourages club members' children who may not currently play golf to gain an interest through this exciting, fun, team-based program.
