CIVILIAN / PUBLIC PLAY AT FJGC!

We are excited to announce a new daily access opportunity to play a round of golf at Fort Jackson Golf Club for your civilian friends, neighbors, and family members. We need your help to get the word out!

Columbia area golfers can now play Fort Jackson Golf Club on a daily basis without being accompanied/sponsored by an Authorized Patron. This new policy also allows our Frequent Guest patrons to have guests join them for a round of golf.

Civilian golfers need to stop by the Visitor Control Center located just inside Gate #2/Forest Drive. Each person will need to present their current driver's license in order to have a quick background check performed. Once the background check is completed successfully, their license will be noted in the DBIDS system to allow installation access through all gates for SIX MONTHS! No additional card will be issued, simply present the driver's license which will be scanned by security personnel at the gate.

Civilian golfers can obtain weekday tee times by calling the FJGC Golf Shop (803-787-4344) one day in advance. Individuals can call the Golf Shop on Thursdays to schedule their request weekend and holiday tee times. Payment of applicable daily fee is required.

CIVILIAN PLAY PUNCH CARD: Each Civilian player that has registered for the six month access and provides their contact information (address, phone number and email) will be presented a Civilian Play Punch Card which rewards them with a FREE 18-hole round with cart on their sixth visit!

GUEST DAY POLICY AND DATES (NEW SATURDAY GUEST DAY)

To provide FJGC members with a greater opportunity to take advantage of our monthly Guest Days, FJGC members are now permitted to bring up to three guests after 11:00 a.m. on Guest Days. Prior to 11:00 a.m., FJGC members are permitted to bring only one guest. Also, green fees are waived for your guest(s), but each guest must pay cart and user fees. Monthly Guest Days are scheduled for the SECOND WEDNESDAY, FOURTH THURSDAY and a SATURDAY of each month.

VETERAN INSTALLATION ACCESS

Honorably Discharged Veterans with a Veteran's Health Identification Card (VHIC) are now permitted to play golf at Fort Jackson Golf Club on a daily basis or by joining FJGC. Initially, you will be required to enter Fort Jackson through Gate2/Forest Drive/ I77 Exit 12, present your VHIC to the security guard and you will be directed to the Visitor Control Center. Visitor Control Center personnel will then conduct a background check. Once cleared through the background check, your VHIC Card will be scanned into the DBIDS System. This will provide you access to the Installation for THREE years and you will be permitted access through all gates. If you bring additional guests in your vehicle, you must come through Gate 2 and pass a background check at the Visitor Control Center. Once the background check is complete, they will be issued a day pass and must be with you at all times.

GET YOUR REAL ID NOW!

Department of Homeland Security has granted South Carolina's request for extension to become REAL ID compliant. Starting next October, Fort Jackson will no longer accept South Carolina Driver's License as the sole form of identification. Though it is NOT mandatory for a SC resident to get a SC REAL ID DL, but for entry onto military installations, air travel, etc. REAL ID is required.

Golf Club members/patrons without a form of identification that is REAL ID compliant are encouraged to obtain the South Carolina REAL ID Driver's License.

If a person elects not to get a REAL ID, they must provide additional identification in order to access the Installation. Acceptable forms of identification are as follows:

- Proof of Identity
 - Examples: Birth certificate or valid US Passport
- Proof of Social Security Number
 Examples: Social security card or W-2 Form that has your social security number and name and your employer's name
- Two Proofs of Current, Physical SC Address
 Examples: Current, unexpired SC license or ID and a no more than 90-day-old utility bill with the same name and address
- Proof of all Legal Name Changes
 Examples: Marriage license or court order issued by your county's probate or family court. One must show a complete name change history that links your birth certificate name to your present day name. If you have a valid US Passport or US Passport Card with your legal name, you may use that as your name change document.

NATIONAL DRIVE, CHIP & PUTT QUALIFIER RETURNS

Fort Jackson Golf Club has again been selected as one of three "Sub Regional" qualifying sites in the Carolinas for the National Drive, Chip & Putt Championship on Saturday, August 27, 2022. Approximately 180 juniors are expected to compete in the various age classifications. The driving range and large putting green will be closed until 3:00pm to conduct the competition.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR DRIVE, CHIP & PUTT

To support the Drive, Chip & Putt "Sub Regional" qualifier on Saturday, August 27, FJGC will need approximately 20 VOLUNTEERS available from 8:00am until approximately 3:00pm. Volunteers will assist with registration, scoring, etc. This is a great opportunity to showcase FJGC and Fort Jackson, and your time and efforts will be greatly appreciated. HANDICAP CART POLICY

Recently, numerous concerns have been voiced regarding abuse of the Handicap Cart Policy. In order to obtain enhanced cart access due to physical limitations, one must submit the required documentation to the Admin Office which is then reviewed by members of the GAC. Patrons are reminded that carts MUST be kept at least 20 feet from the putting surfaces. Also, carts are NOT permitted between the green and bunkers. Everyone's cooperation is greatly appreciated.
