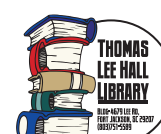

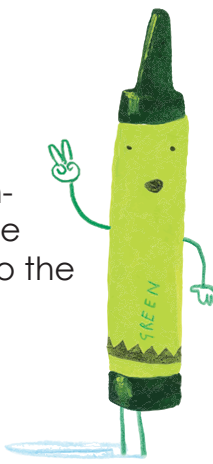

## Get Started with Beanstack



### Step 1: Sign Up

Go to our Summer Reading website: <https://thomasleehall.beanstack.org>.

### Step 2: Register

Select Register an Individual or Family in the middle of the page.

### Step 3: Select who you are going to register for Summer Reading

• **I am registering myself** - Only use this option if you have your own email, and do not want to be part of a family account. You must be at least 13 years old to create your own account. You will log in and track independently of anyone else in your family. An individual account can't be added to an existing family account without losing progress and prizes earned.

- Select "I am registering myself."
- Fill in the requested information on the sign up form.
- Select the program for your age group.

• **I am an adult registering a child** - Pick this to sign-up each family member and yourself. Everyone in a family can access the account with the same username and password. Each member can track progress and earn prizes at their own pace. Adults do not have to sign themselves up to log minutes. You can have just kid(s) on the family account.



- Select "I am an adult registering a child."
- Fill in the sign up form with both your and your child's information.
- Select the program for your child's age group.
- If needed add another family member to the account.

## How to Log Minutes with Beanstack

Step 1: Log into your Beanstack account.

Step 2: Select Log Reading and Activities at the top of the page.

Step 3: Select Minutes for log type.

Step 4: Select the date you are logging for.

Step 5: Enter the amount of time spent reading. Adding a title and author is optional. Click on the Log button to finish.

June 7-19, June 21- July 2, July 5-17, and July 19-31

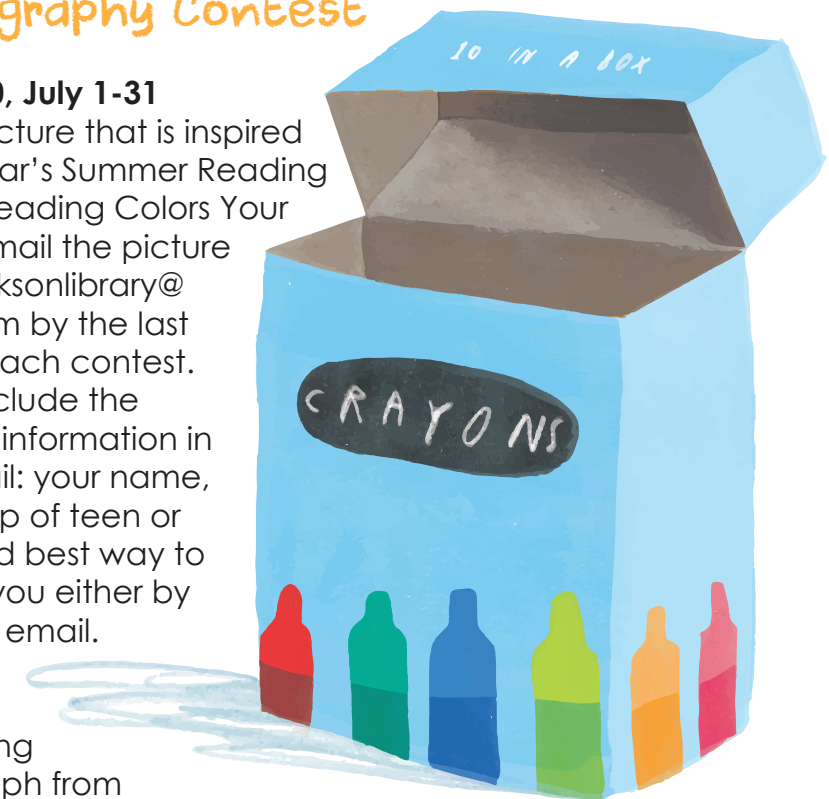
